



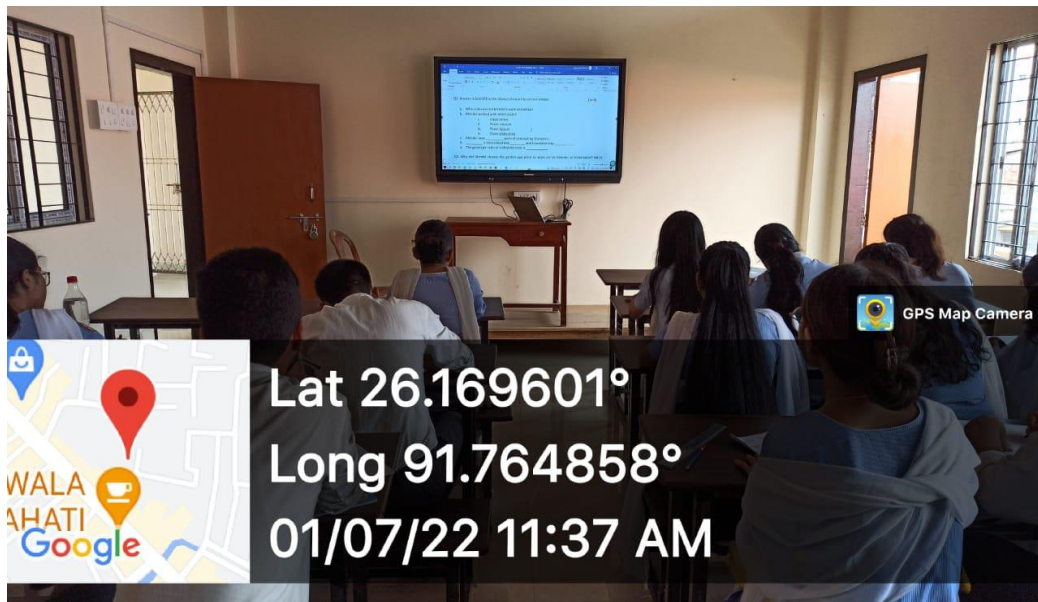

### Online Education

The main website of the College is [www.sbdeorahcollege.org.in](http://www.sbdeorahcollege.org.in) which comprehensively reflects all aspects of the College. We opened this portal mainly for the purpose of carrying out the online activities of the College. Students' new admission, re-admission, casual admission, examination form fill up, deposit of various fees by the students are operated through this portal. We have prepared different modules for each of these activities and activate them at the appropriate time. For example, at the time of New Admissions in the College we activate the module for New Admission and as soon as admissions are over, we temporarily close that module. Students' database and records of accounts of online financial transactions are also maintained in this portal. Apart from offering online classes to the students through video conferencing, development of E-Content of the programmes/courses offered in the College is one of our key focussed areas. For this purpose, the teachers are engaged in preparation of 'Study materials' and 'Class videos'. We have been uploading these E-contents in this portal for the benefit of students of our College in particular and the Students community in general.

### Step by step guide for Online Form-fillup

1. Click the 'Apply Online' button
2. Then click the 'New Enrolment' button and register yourself by filling required fields. The candidate should have a valid Email ID and Mobile No. for registration.
3. After successfully registering, the candidate has to fill up the application form part by part by clicking the "save next" button
4. Candidate has to fill Bank Account details like Bank Name, Branch Name, Account No. and IFSC number as given in the form.
5. Upload passport size photograph and signature of the candidate. The size of the passport sized photograph and scanned signature should preferably be less than 5 MB.
6. Documents needed to be uploaded during form fill up:
  - Last Examination Mark-sheet (Compulsory)
  - Caste Certificate (If applied for quota)
  - Income Certificate (If applied for)
  - Domicile State Certificate (Compulsory)
  - Copy of Bank Passbook/Cheque (Compulsory)
7. After filling up all the details correctly, the candidate has to preview the Application Form.
8. Candidates belonging to States other than Assam will have to pay the prospectus fees by clicking "Final Submit" button. After the payment is successful, their application will be completely submitted and they can download their Application form respectively.
9. Applicants belonging to Assam can download their application form after clicking the "Final Submit" button.

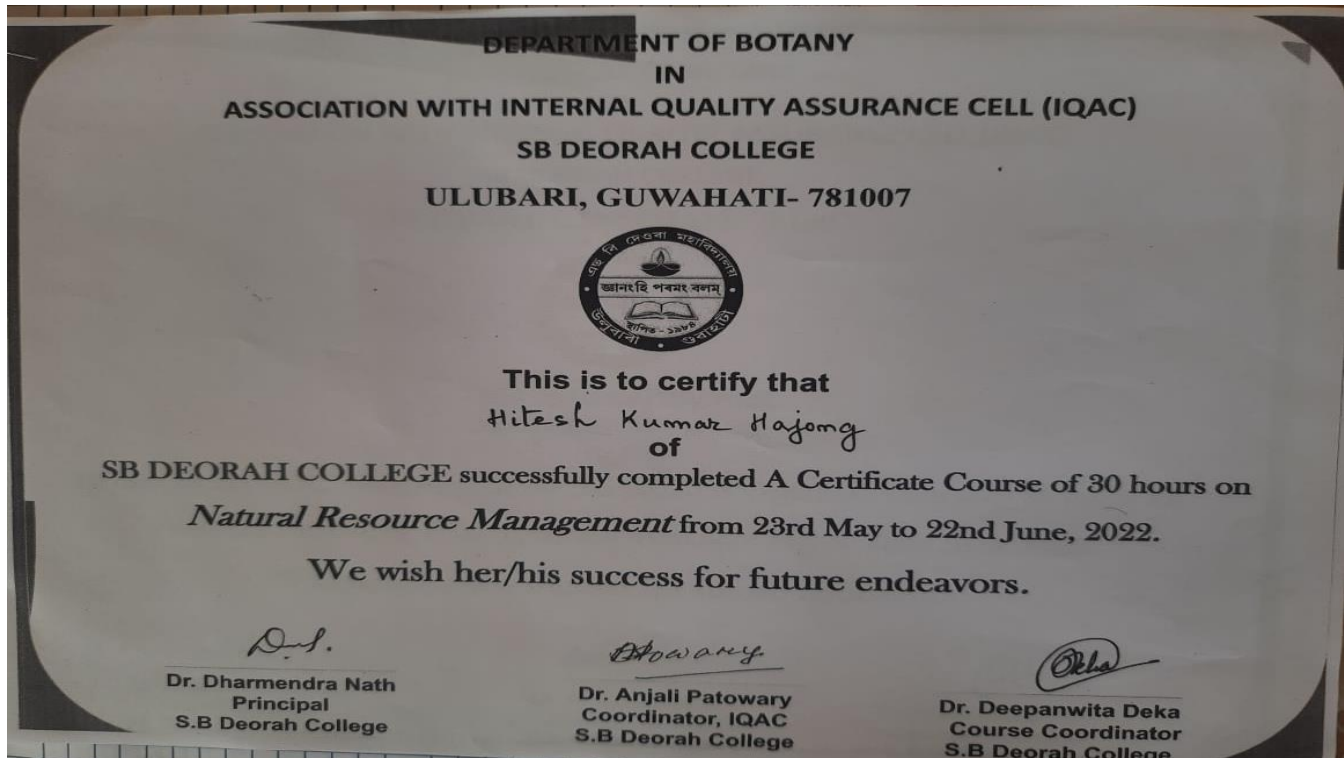

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**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)**

**ARYA VIDYAPEETH COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)**

&

**S. B. DEORAH COLLEGE**

GUWAHATI: 781 007, ASSAM

Date: 18/8/2022

Venue: Guwahati

9. This is a non-binding MoU and there shall be no financial obligation on the part of both Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) and S. B. Deorah College. Both Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) and S. B. Deorah College agree that any information which is exchanged pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding will be kept strictly confidential and used solely for the purpose, covered by this Memorandum of Understanding, unless such information was obtained by a third party who does not have an obligation of confidentiality toward the information disclosing party and entered public domain.

Subject to clause below, both the institutions may amend this Memorandum of Understanding by mutual consent in writing. Any amendment agreed by the institutions shall come into effect from the date determined by the signing Colleges on potential areas. This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall initially be valid for a period of three years. Thereafter both Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) and S. B. Deorah College shall agree on mutual consent on the continued validity of this Memorandum of Understanding.

In any other circumstance, or other detailed collaboration between the two parties, a separate MoA shall be drawn up as and when required.

The Institutions, Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) and S. B. Deorah College, agree that this Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the basis of goodwill and shall not be legally bound. Nothing mentioned in this Memorandum of Understanding shall deem constitute partnership between the signing institutions appointing one party as an agent of the other.

This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective upon signature by both the Head of Institutions for a period of three years, at which time it will be renewed for possible renewal for further three-year period. Either party may, on three (3) months' notice in writing, terminate the MoU in advance of its normal expiration or request the recognition of its conditions.

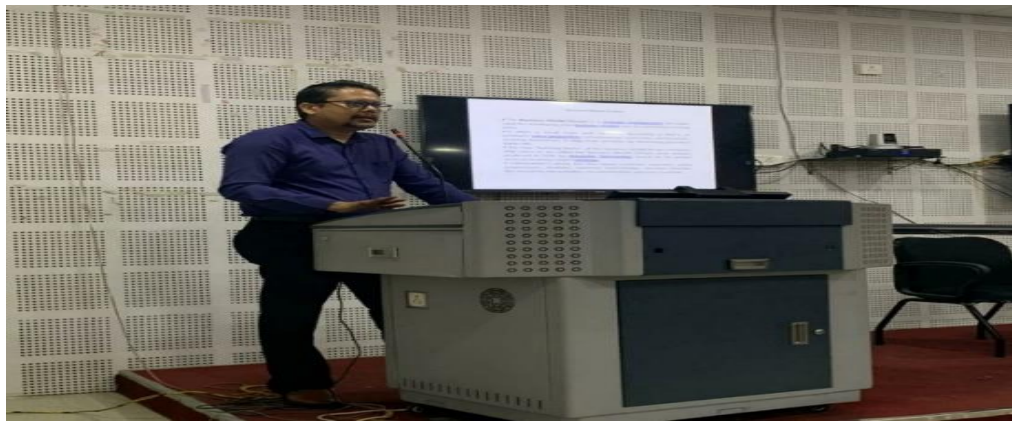
