



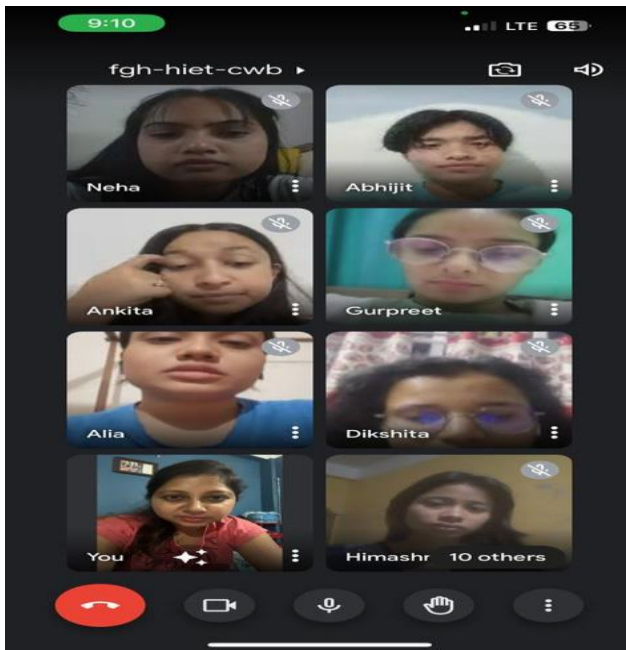

She Stoops to Conquer by Oliver Goldsmith

About the author:

- Oliver Goldsmith was a well known Anglo-Irish novelist, playwright, dramatist and poet.
- Goldsmith was known for his novel *The Vicar of Wakefield*, published in 1766, which Goldsmith had written in 1762.
- He was also known for his pastoral poem "The Deserted Village" (1770).
- The play, *She Stoops to Conquer*, was written in 1773 and was an immediate success. While clearly taking inspiration from Restoration Comedies, Goldsmith's mission was to render a more natural take on the comedy of his time.

She Stoops to Conquer is a comedy by Oliver Goldsmith, first performed in London in 1773.

- The play was initially titled as *Mistakes of a Night* and the events within the play take place in one long night. In 1778, John O'Keefe
