Introduction

Objectives

The objectives of this policy are:

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- 3. Ensure safe handling, storage and disposal of wastes in campus.
- 4. Adhere to the use of bio-degradable disposable cups and plates and limiting even the usage of single use plastic in campus.
- 5. To expand recycling opportunities on the college campus and seek measures to transform waste into value added products.
- 6. To promote holistic approach of waste management in campus.

Measures of Waste Management in college

Solid Waste Management:

Students shall be instructed to avoid generating waste. Solid wastes shall be segregated into Dry and Wet Wastes and deposited in Blue and Green bins respectively. The waste will be then collected and disposed of by Guwahati Municipal Corporation through their designated NGO's. Paper trash shall be either directly sold for recycling or shredded in an electronic shredder machine. Incinerators are being installed for proper disposal of sanitary napkins.

Liquid Waste Management:

Liquid waste generated in the toilets, canteen etc, are passed into the internal drainage system in the college. Liquid wastes from laboratories are collected in soak pit.

Electronic Wastes Management:

The College endeavours to facilitate the management of electronic waste by ensuring safe disposal of E-waste. Towards this, the college looks forward to partner with NGOs or government recognised bodies for scientific and safe disposal of electronic waste.
